| Recommended equipment for trip leaders includes all the above, plus: | |
| Marine VHF radio Current tables Waterproof flashlight Spare paddle Extra flares Weather radio (if no VHF) | Rescue slings Repair kit: pliers, duct tape, screw driver, etc. Sleeping bag in dry sack Tarp or tent Extra food |
